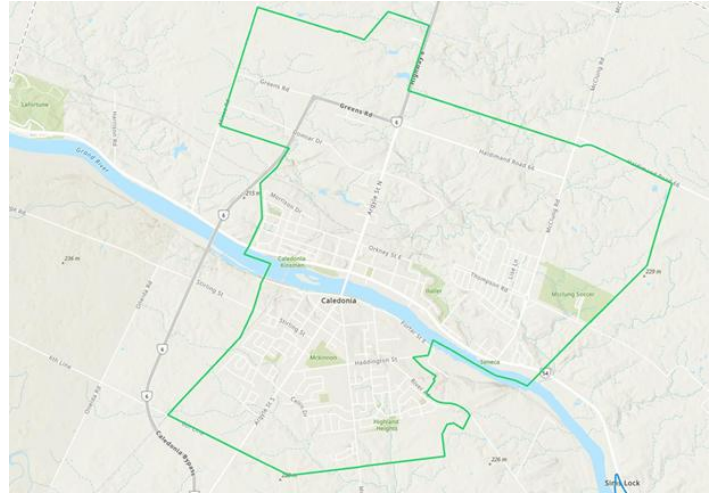

Caledonia Master Servicing Plan Update

THE STUDY

Haldimand County has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) to update the Master Servicing Plan (MSP) prepared for the community of Caledonia. The purpose of this study is to update the four (4) servicing components of the Caledonia MSP (water, wastewater, stormwater and transportation) to reflect updated land use and growth forecasts in the study area.

Project information is being posted to the Haldimand County's website to allow stakeholders an opportunity to review project materials and updates associated with this project.
