Cayuga Master Servicing Plan Update


Haldimand County has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) to update the Master Servicing Plan (MSP) prepared in 2010 for the community of Cayuga.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The purpose of this study was to update the four (4) servicing components (water, wastewater, stormwater, transportation) of the previous Cayuga MSP to reflect updated land use and growth forecasts in the study area. The updated MSP will guide future infrastructure projects in the community.

This study was conducted according to the requirements of Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Engineers Association MCEA process, which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act. This Master Plan was completed with sufficient detail to fulfill the requirements for Schedule 'B' projects (Approach 2).

Approved projects include new and upgraded watermains, sanitary sewers, stormwater sewers, booster pump stations, sewage pump stations, and stormwater management infrastructure as well as transportation upgrades to include new and optimized signalized intersections. While the Master Plan addresses Haldimand's servicing needs at a broad level, more detailed studies will be conducted at a later date for some of the projects identified in the Master Plan.
