- Using the template provided, colour and design a 25-cent Haldimand County Coin that shows what makes Haldimand County special to you. Students should be creative, have fun, and make it their own!
- A limit of one (1) entry will be accepted per student. Contest is open to all school-age children in Haldimand County from Kindergarten through Grade 8.
- Entries must be submitted by the deadline of **March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026** to be considered. Submissions can be made in person at the Haldimand County Administration Building, digitally via [www.Haldimandcounty.ca/haldimand25](http://www.Haldimandcounty.ca/haldimand25) or by email to [tlong@haldimandcounty.ca](mailto:tlong@haldimandcounty.ca) (teachers may complete a bulk entry if they choose).
- By submitting a drawing to this contest, the entrant agrees to give Haldimand County the irrevocable right to use, edit, reproduce, publish and transmit the submitted art work and information provided throughout the world in any media, website, publication, advertising/marketing/promotional materials and electronic media without any additional compensation.
- Additionally, each entrant will grant permission to Haldimand County to contact them, using the parent/guardian contact information provided on their submission.
- Prizes will be awarded to the winning designs from the following categories: K-Gr 3, Gr 4 – Gr 6 & Gr 7 – 8.
- Designs will be reviewed by a panel of judges and are reviewed without identifying information. Judging is to take place in April following the submission deadline.
