

What to know about Haldimand Pools

Swimming Lessons and Certifications

- All Haldimand pools offer the *Lifesaving Society's Swim to Survive*® program that develops solid swimming skills and incorporates valuable *Water Smart*® education that will last a lifetime. Lessons are available for all ages.
- Advanced lifeguarding courses (i.e. Bronze Star, Medallion, Cross) teach participants to be life savers and are offered at all Haldimand pools.

Pool Rules

To ensure all patrons can enjoy their swim safely, the following rules are enforced:

- **NO** running;
- Outdoor shoes cannot be worn on the pool deck;
- **NO** glass containers, food or beverages are allowed in the pool area;
- Do **NOT** enter the pool if you have an open sore, rash or are experiencing nausea, vomiting or diarrhea;
- **NO** person shall pollute/foul the pool water or the deck in any manner;



- **NO** rough/boisterous play is permitted in or around the pool;
- Lifejackets or personal floatation devices (PFDs) can only be used during a Public Swim or Family Swim when a parent or guardian is "within arm's reach" of their child;
- Spectator viewing is in designated areas only;
- Patrons may be requested to perform a swim test at the discretion of the lifeguard on duty to ensure their safety in the deep end;
- Diving is **ONLY** permitted in the diving pool/ designated areas;
- Acceptable bathing attire must be worn and is a. clean; b. used for the **sole purpose** of bathing (e.g.: no street clothes, blue jeans, cargo pants, loose fitting clothing); c. should not impede or limit the mobility of a bather. Swim diapers or plastic pants are required for children who wear diapers.

AF Aqua Fit: An “all-exercise” workout- no swimming skills required. (Mainly in the shallow end.)

FAM Family Swim: A great opportunity for families to enjoy some fun time together. Children must be accompanied in the pool by an adult.

FIT Fitness Swim: Provides swimmers with a chance to swim, walk or run lengths in the pool. Please follow proper lane etiquette.

IS Inclusive Swim (Caledonia only): Includes the option to use a water wheelchair or pool toys for sensory engagement, no music and fewer swimmers in the pool.

PS Public Swim: A time for children and adults of all ages to come swimming.
