

# THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

## By-law No. 718/06

**Being a by-law to repeal By-law No. 711/06 and to prescribe maximum rates of speed for the portion of McKenzie Road between York Road and Fuller Drive**

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**WHEREAS** Section 11.(1) of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c.25 provides that a single tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting traffic on highways under its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS** Section 128.(2) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.8 provides that the council of a municipality may by by-law prescribe maximum rates of speed for motor vehicles driven on a highway or a portion of a highway under its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacted by-law No. 711/06 on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2006, to reduce the maximum rate of speed to sixty kilometres per hour (60km/h) on a portion of McKenzie Road for the purpose of accommodating traffic detoured as a result of the native occupation at Caledonia;

**WHEREAS** By-law No. 711/06, as enacted, gives effect to an increase of the speed limit on that portion of McKenzie Road which is contained within the urban boundary of Caledonia;

**AND WHEREAS** in accordance with the general provisions of Section 128.(1) of the said *Highway Traffic Act*, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to retain a speed limit of fifty kilometres per hour (50km/h) on the subject portion of McKenzie Road contained within the urban boundaries of Caledonia;

**NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:**

1. **THAT** By-law No. 711/06 be hereby repealed.
2. **THAT** no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a rate exceeding sixty kilometres per hour (60km/h) on any portion of McKenzie Road commencing at a point measured one hundred and twenty meters (120m) southerly from the centerline of York Road to a point measured one hundred and twenty four meters (124m) southerly from the centerline of Fuller Drive.
3. **THAT** the General Manager of Physical Services for Haldimand County or designate is hereby authorized and directed to place or erect and maintain such official signs or traffic control devices or signals as are required to give effect to the provisions of this by-law or as required to warn or guide traffic for the safety or convenience of the public.
4. **THAT** every person contravening any provision of this by-law is guilty of a fine and upon conviction is subject to a fine recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33, as amended.

5. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any provision of any by-law of The Corporation of Haldimand County with which it is inconsistent.

6. **THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.

READ a first and second time this 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2006.

READ a third time and finally passed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2006.
