

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law No.1623/16

Being a by-law to amend By-law 307/02 to regulate parking in Haldimand County, Dunnville

WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

WHEREAS in accordance with the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, The Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County enacted By-law 307/02 to regulate and govern traffic and the parking of vehicles on private or municipal property in Haldimand County;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County now deems it expedient to amend By-law 307/02 with respect to Schedule "C" of said By-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the following section of Schedule "C" "No Parking" – Dunnville be repealed:

Street	Side	From	To	Period
Broad Street	South	Tamarac Street	15 meters easterly	Anytime

2. **THAT** the following section be added to form part of Schedule "C" "No Parking" – Dunnville:

Street	Side	From	To	Period
Broad Street	South	Tamarac Street	30 meters easterly	Anytime

3. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any other by-law with which it is inconsistent.
4. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.

READ a first and second time this 18th day of January, 2016.

READ a third time and finally passed this 18th day of January, 2016.
