

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law No. 1168/11

Being a by-law to provide remuneration to all Haldimand County Police Services Board Members and to repeal Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk By-law No. 55/99

WHEREAS Section 283 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001 allows a municipality to pay any part of the remuneration and expenses of the members of any local board of the municipality;

WHEREAS Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk By-law No. 55/99, being a by-law to amend By-law No 48-83 respecting remuneration and expenses, was passed on the 13th day of May, 1999;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to repeal By-law No. 55/99 and replace it with a By-law to provide remuneration to all Haldimand County Police Services Board members, whether provincially appointed or municipally appointed as a citizen or Council Representative;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the remuneration for appointees to the Haldimand County Police Services Board members, whether provincially appointed or municipally appointed as a citizen or Council representative, be set at \$4,000 per annum.
2. **THAT** the remuneration for the Chair of the Haldimand County Police Services Board be supplemented by a premium of \$1,200 per annum.
3. **THAT** any remuneration received by virtue of being a member of the Police Services Board is excluded from earnings for Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Savings (OMERS) purposes.
4. **THAT** the remuneration shall be provided to elected Council representatives appointed to the Police Services Board as of January 1, 2011.
5. **THAT** Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk By-law No. 55/99 is hereby repealed.
6. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.

READ a first and second time this 15th day of February, 2011.

READ a third time and finally passed this 15th day of February, 2011.
