

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law No. 1629/16

Being a by-law to regulate traffic in Haldimand County – All Way Stop Condition, Oneida Road at 6th Line, Caledonia.

WHEREAS Section 137 subsection (a) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R. S. O. 1990., c. H.8, as amended, authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws providing for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to install an all way stop condition at a certain intersection within Haldimand County;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** an All Way Stop condition be established as follows:

TRAFFIC DIRECTION	INTERSECTION (AT)
All Way	Oneida Road at 6 th Line

2. **THAT** every person operating a vehicle shall comply with any traffic control device erected in compliance with this by-law.
3. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any by-law with which it is inconsistent.
4. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 8th day of February, 2016.

READ a third time and finally passed this 8th day of February, 2016.
