

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law No. 1733/16

**Being a by-law to regulate traffic in Haldimand County.
Installation of a stop sign, South Coast Drive at Cheapside
Road.**

WHEREAS Section 137 subsection (a) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990., c.H.8, as amended, authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws providing for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS Haldimand County deems it expedient to install a stop sign at a certain intersection within Haldimand County;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** a stop sign be installed as follows:

TRAFFIC DIRECTION	STREET	INTERSECTION (AT)
Eastbound	South Coast Drive	Cheapside Road

2. **THAT** every person operating a vehicle shall comply with any traffic control device erected in compliance with this by-law.
3. **THAT** the by-law shall take precedence over any by-law with which it is inconsistent.
4. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 1st day of November, 2016.

READ a third time and finally passed this 1st day of November, 2016.
