

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number 1866/17

Being a by-law to regulate traffic in Haldimand County - Stop Condition, Dunnville

WHEREAS Section 137 subsection (a) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990., c.H.8, as amended, authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws providing for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to install a stop condition at a certain intersection within Haldimand County,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** a stop condition be established as follows:

TRAFFIC DIRECTION	STREET	INTERSECTION (AT)
Northbound	Maple Street	Front Street

2. **THAT** every person operating a vehicle shall comply with any traffic control device erected in compliance with this by-law;
3. **THAT** every person contravening any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is subject to a fine recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33 as amended;
4. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any by-law with which is inconsistent
5. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 20th day of November, 2017.

READ a third time and finally passed this 20th day of November, 2017.
