

| Trail/Pathway/Cycling Route/Boat Launch | Description |
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| Caledonia | |
| Chippewa Trail | A natural trail to walk/run/cycle. Approximately 2.7 km and runs from Haldibrook Rd., south to Unity Rd. where it crosses and proceeds further south to Haldimand Rd. #66. Roadside parking. |
| Gypsum Mine Tract | The Gypsum Mine Tract connects in Caledonia to the Chippewa trail in the west. The Tract runs off-road east to Haldimand Road #9 then on-road south on #9 to Highway 54 in York. Users can then join the off-road Rotary Riverside Trail to head west back to Caledonia or travel over the Grand River to link up with the Green Cycling Route to Caledonia to the northwest and Cayuga to the southeast. |
| Haldimand Tour Cycling Route | McKinnon Park-100 Haddington St. Caledonia. The route is 71 km of rolling hills. It is a scenic route along the Grand River, Lake Erie and back roads of Haldimand County. |
| Kinsmen Park Walkway | Paved and lit throughout Kinsmen Park on the north side of the Grand River. |
| Patterson Walkway | Paved and lit on the east side of Argyle Street between the Grand River and Forfar Street. |
| Ramsay Walkway | Paved and lit trail on the west side of Argyle Street between the Grand River and Forfar Street destined for the Caledonia Old Mill. |
| Thistlemoor Park Pathway | Within the limits of Thistlemoor Park, in the south end of Caledonia. |
| Rotary Riverside Trail | Designated as part of the Trans Canada Trail System, this trail is approximately 6 km of scenic Grand River country, suitable for nature walks, hiking and cycling. Parking at Seneca Park. |
| Cayuga | |
| Cayuga Grand Vista | The Cayuga Grand Vista is a looped route that has parking at the Courthouse, 55 Munsee St. in Cayuga. Users can walk down the off-road route to the bridge and take in the beautiful views of the Grand River. The loop continues over the bridge to a second parking lot off King George St. Users can head east on King George into Cayuga through town and back to the Courthouse or west to the on-road route to River Road. Here cyclist join the Green Route to either Caledonia or east/southeast on the route. |
| River Route Cycling Route | Cayuga Kinsmen Park-61 Ouse St. S. Cayuga. Parking and washrooms available in park. The route is 69 km of paved, flat to rolling hill roads. It travels along the Grand River and Lake Erie. |
| Dunnville | |
| Blue Heron Way | Blue Heron Way is approximately 1.1 kms of off road trails connecting Dunnville to the Niagara Region. This trail links up to the Gord Harry Trail to Niagara. |
| Dunnville Walking Path | 2 km of paved walkway from Centennial Park in Dunnville through Lions Park, on the sidewalk to Wingfield Park and along the Grand River to the Farmers Market. |
| Lowbanks Loop Cycling Route | Dunnville Kinsmen Park-985 John St., Dunnville. Parking and washrooms available in park. The route is 47 km of paved, mostly flat roads. It travels along the Feeder Canal and Lake Erie. |
| Rail Park Pathway | A short scenic pathway between Cedar Street and George Street. |
| Thompson Creek Restoration | Natural regenerated area reforested with Carolinian trees and frequented by various wildlife. |
| Hagersville | |
| Hagersville and Area Cycling Route | Grant Kett Park-38 Sherring St. N. Hagersville. Parking and washrooms available in park. The route is 51 km of paved and mostly flat roads. Scenic route through Hagersville and Townsend. |
| Jarvis | |
| Jarvis Lions Walking Trail | 1.2 km of paved walkway, fully accessible with solar lighting, mature trees and benches. |
| Selkirk | |
| Lakeview Tour Cycling Route | Selkirk Athletic Field-17 Main St. W. Selkirk. Parking and washrooms available in park. The route is 70 km of paved and mostly flat roads. It is a picturesque route along Lake Erie through Selkirk, Fisherville, Sweets Corners and Cheapside. |
| Waterfront Way | Short trail with walking bridge, Parkette located 200 metres South at Lake Erie contains scenic lookout and parking. |
| Townsend | |
| Townsend Recreation Trail | 3 Kms of paved and lit walkway winding through beautiful Townsend over the Nanticoke Creek. Available for walking, biking and roller-blading. |
| Various Locations | |
| Boat Launches | Haldimand County is home to several boat launches along its many waterways. For more information and details, please pick up a Haldimand County Map & Tour Guide from your local Haldimand County Office. |
| Lake Erie Waterfront Trail | This route travels from Windsor to Fort Erie following the Lake Erie shoreline through lakeside communities in Haldimand. The trail connects with the Lake Ontario Waterfront Trail via the Niagara River Recreational Trail, and runs 1400 km in total. |
