## Prepare NOW ....

#### To ACT QUICKLY

Floods are the most frequent natural Hazards in Canada. They are the most dangerous in Ontario in terms of property damage, disruption and even death.



Floods are typically caused by:

- Melting snow
- Ice storms
- Heavy spring rains
- Summer thunderstorms

Flash flooding is often caused by:

- Violent rain storm
- Breaking dams

Disconnect electrical	Keep Children and Pets away

Do not EAT food that came	Obey signs and take alternate
