Water Boil Advisory

What is

A Boil Water Advisory

Is a recommendation made by Public Health for residents to boil tap water for at least 1 minute before using. This is issued when there is a known or a risk of an microbiological contamination in the water supply.

BOIL IT - COOL IT - USE IT

- BOIL IT** – Boil your water for at least 1 minute at a rolling boil
- COOL IT** – once boiled, cover it and store in refrigerator for later use
- USE IT** – drink it, use it for washing fruits and vegetables or brushing your teeth

BABY FORMULA
Sterilize all bottles, rings, utensils and nipples in boiling water for two minutes. You should boil water at a rolling boil for 2 minutes to sterilize it before mixing it with formula for your baby.

Washing dishes... with a rinse water sink of 30ml bleach to 13.5 liters water soaking for 1 minute	Coffee makers
