

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law No. 855/07

Being a by-law to establish an All Way Stop at the intersection of Queen Street and Lock Street in Dunnville

WHEREAS the Sections 8 and 10 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, confer broad authority upon a municipality to enact by-laws with respect to highways and parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to provide for the erection of All Way Stop Signs at the intersection of Queen Street and Lock Street in Dunnville;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** an All Way Stop condition be established as follows:

Traffic Direction	Intersection (at)
All Way	Queen Street / Lock Street, Dunnville

2. **THAT** every person operating a vehicle shall comply with any traffic control device erected in compliance with this by-law.
3. **THAT** every person contravening any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is subject to a fine recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 33 as amended.
4. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any by-law with which it is inconsistent.
5. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.

READ a first and second time this 24th day of September, 2007.

READ a third time and finally passed this 24th day of September, 2007.
