COVID-19 Outbreak

December 30, 2022

Please be advised that on December 28, 2022 in collaboration with the Haldimand and Norfolk Public Health Unit, a COVID-19 Outbreak was declared on the Hillview home area.

A total of 14 residents are presenting with symptoms associated with COVID-19. PCR swabs of symptomatic residents have been collected and sent for testing. Of the 14 swabs collected, 6 are confirmed positive for COVID-19, 3 have been confirmed negative. Additionally, 3 staff members have also tested positive for COVID-19. All residents and staff are in stable condition.

Please note that for the duration of the outbreak the Hillview home area will be restricted to Essential Caregivers only. This designation requires caregivers to complete the home's Essential Caregiver Course and be listed as an essential caregiver on your resident's visitor list.

Grandview Lodge remains committed to minimizing the transmission of infectious diseases throughout the home and we appreciate your assistance by continued self-screening and active screening for symptoms prior to visiting including the completion of a rapid antigen test (RAT), diligent use of a surgical mask and frequent hand hygiene.

Anyone visiting a positive or symptomatic resident is asked to wear the designated personal protective equipment (PPE) – including eye protection, mask, gown and gloves.
