# 7. Business Arising

## 7.1 Signage Strategy

The Community Partnerships Liaison gave a brief introduction to the current Storyboard signage project being undertaken by Heritage Haldimand in partnership with the Dunnville and District Heritage Association. The project encompasses 13 storyboards - 12 in Dunnville relating to the history of the community, are to be placed along the walkway of Garfield Disher and Wingfield Parks and, the thirteenth in Esplanade Park, Port Maitland, features Dollier & Galinée. Eight (8) of the Dunnville boards are complete with panels featuring the Grand

River; Bridges, Dams and Floods; Electric Company and TH&B railway; and Indigenous history to be completed.

With the County's Comprehensive Signage Strategy in place, Heritage Haldimand is now in a position to implement the requirements relating to signage specifications.

The timeline for installation of the storyboards is not set; however, it is expected that the signage will be installed before the fall of 2023.

Sylvia Weaver will contact historian and expert on Black History in Niagara and the Underground Railroad, Rochelle Bush to be the keynote speaker.

Emancipation Day observes the August 1, 1834 date when the Slavery Abolition Act of 1833 came into effect across the British Empire.
