1. Welcome and Introduction

Meeting called to order by Chair Hedley at 6:00 p.m.

2. Declarations of Conflict of Interest

3. Approval of the Minutes

4. Road Concerns Discussion

K. Franklin introduced himself to the committee and addressed the Road concerns brought forward in previous meetings. The Committee raised concerns regarding road sizes and curbs causing tractors to push farther into oncoming traffic, highlighting the York bridge area. Discussion noted future construction projects to include consultation with the Agriculture community and noted considerations for farm equipment sizes. Another concern brought forward was the need for increased awareness and education to the public during farming seasons, raising awareness of the tractors on the roads in order to ensure public safety.

- In school education on agricultural careers, such as job fairs, postsecondary training, and recruiting volunteers to speak in schools.

Increasing Value add Agriculture Opportunities:

- Education on farm policies, permitted uses and guidelines
- Education to public about farming

- Council recently passed a motion seeking the Province's assistance in the upkeep of abandoned cemeteries
- Upcoming Harrop drain public meeting providing farmers an opportunity to provide feedback regarding drain maintenance
- Archeological Management Plan underway
